



Minutes: Membership meeting 20 September 2020

I. Call to order

- a. President Don Kile called the meeting to order at: 2:07 PM
- b. Officers present: President Don Kile, Vice President Willie Fields, Recording Secretary Karen Klingler.
- c. There were 23 members physically present, plus one on the phone.

II. Pledge of allegiance

- a. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by the Membership present.

III. Reading of previous meeting's minutes

- a. August 2020 Minutes were read by Recording Secretary Karen Klingler.
- b. Approval of minutes: Approved unanimously by membership present.

IV. Presentation of the monthly financial statement

- a. Karen Klingler read the financial summary submitted by the Treasurer.
- b. The Financial Statement was unanimously approved by membership.

VI. Old Business

- a. Don shared the winners of the last raffle, who are also posted on the website.
- b. The August Work Meeting resulted in the following completed activities:
 - i. Bar project – moving the bar along the west wall
 - ii. Painting pistol range shelter wooden areas
 - iii. Back wall – foundation. Holes were dug and lined with tubes, cement was mixed and poured.
 - iv. Pond lawn work was completed as close to the marshy edge as possible.
- c. No questions or concerns raised about the members' page.
- d. Don had the weed-wackers serviced.
- e. Don reiterated that .22 caliber pistols are not to be used only for paper targets, not for the metal targets, on the pistol range. The .22 is not powerful enough to handle the metal targets and there is a high potential for ricochets hitting people.

- b. November 8th, 2020 we are planning a splatter board shoot. Question from Joe Z. is whether we should invite the public. Membership present were in favor of opening it to the public.

- c. Fishing Derby Committee:
 - i. Looking at May 15, 16th 2021
 - ii. The duties of the committee should start in January 2021 so there is no rush to complete all of the acquisitions and planning at the time of the derby. Ralph is cautioning that we need to start early, and he has a checklist of items to be completed for the Derby to use as a guide. Everything should be here by the week before the fishing derby.
